



Welcome!

Welcome to Concord, New Hampshire for the 1883 Black Ice Pond Hockey Championship. The event will again be held at White Park, one of the oldest municipal parks in the State of New Hampshire. The Park was also placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1982. We hope that you enjoy this organized pond hockey experience on the pond where so many Capital City Area kids learned how to skate for the first time.

The Black Ice Pond Hockey Tournament now in its 3rd year has captured the interest of the entire city. This weekend has become the unofficial winter celebration and social gathering. The positive response from so many businesses supporting the event has allowed us to give over \$70,000 to date, back to the community.

Each of the 85 teams will compete in one of 6 divisions separated by age and ability. Each team is scheduled to play a total of 4

games, two on Friday and two on Saturday, with the hopes of making it to Sunday's Semifinals and Finals. Those teams, who are fortunate enough to be called 2013 Black Ice Champions, will also earn the coveted "Hobey Stick". The sticks are crafted out of ash by W.S. Dennison and engraved by Mark Ruddy both of Concord are a great showpiece of hockey and the greatest amateur hockey player. White Park is settled in a neighborhood in the middle of Concord. We ask that you please respect people's property. Parking is allowed on ONE SIDE of the city street around White Park, please obey the signs. There will be plenty of parking in the park. Please use the designated parking spaces in the paved parking lot as well as the parking available on the grass plowed areas around the

pond. Our friends at the UNH School of Law, next to White Park have made

their parking lot on Washington Street available to the players after 4pm on
Friday and during the tournament on Saturday and Sunday. The Black Ice Shuttle provided by Patsy's Bus Sales of Concord will be
available for all players on an "on call" basis. The shuttle will be able to deliver players and guests to the Official Main Street
Restaurants and Official Hotels. If parking becomes an issue we hope to have the ability to use the shuttle for off site parking will be a premium, Concord residents are reminded to car pool!

Open container and public consumption of alcohol is not permitted in White Park, as well as, the city streets. Public intoxication

is not allowed in the city parks either. Please be smart!

We are all gathering to enjoy hockey in the purist form and bring us back to the roots of where the game started, in Concord, and on the pond. The 1883 Black Ice Pond Hockey Association, a non-profit entity has a mission to help maintain and expand ice skating opportunities throughout the City of Concord. Concord, like many northern cities, had ponds and sheets of ice maintained in many city parks for the public to use. But over the years budgets were trimmed and those skating opportunities went away. The Black Ice contributions have brought many of those skating opportunities back, as well as, assisting entities like Concord Youth Hockey to make the initial hockey experience more affordable. (We hope that we can expand this opportunity to many areas in the city in the future). We can only wish for great weather, but we all embrace the experience.

White Park Skate House Project



In the fall of 2009, the 1883 Black Ice Pond Hockey Association was created to develop and run a pond hockey tournament in White Park, Concord, NH. The non-profit entity has a mission to help maintain and expand ice skating opportunities throughout the City of Concord. Concord, like many northern cities, had ponds and sheets of ice maintained in many city parks for the public to use. But over the years budgets were trimmed and those skating opportunities went away. Over the past two tournaments the Black Ice has given the City of Concord Parks & Recreation department \$25,000 which has gone towards rehabbing an area at Rollins Park and adding lights for skating, coordinated the dredging of White Park Pond and purchased a liner for the hockey rink at White Park for a more consistent ice surface. The funds that have not been used are being earmarked for the construction of a new multipurpose facility. The proposed facility is in the city master plan and will replace the old skate house. It will also provide the park with a facility that can be used year-round for events and recreation. HL Turner Company in Concord has donated their services to design and engineer the proposed building. Last week the Concord City Council gave the preliminary approval of the building

design. We are excited to show the plans to the public during this year's Black Ice Tournament. We hope that this promotes an opportunity to discuss the impact this facility will make on the Park and the community. In the upcoming months the Black Ice Association will be working closely with Park N Rec. and the Concord Community to raise the funds needed to get this building erected.

Pond Hockey Rules & Etiquette

Each of the 85 teams can have up to 7 players on their active roster but are only allowed 4 players on the ice at any time. Games will consist of (2) two 15 minute periods, running time with a 3 minute warm up, and a 3 minute break between periods. There are no goalies in pond hockey; in fact there are no regular hockey nets. Goals are a 6x2 ft. box, made with 2x6 planks, with two 1 ft. slots in the front corners. Goals can only be scored by sliding the puck through the slot into the box. The games will be policed by the players, like a pond or a street hockey game in your youth, where you settled the differences. Sportsmanship is mandatory; any behavior to the contrary will not be tolerated. Fighting is not allowed and will cause the team to have to play a man down for the entire tournament. The player in the fight will not be able to play for the remainder of the tournament. The Tournament will provide a rink monitor who will confirm goals, penalties and possession of the puck. There are no zambonies in pond hockey; it will be customary that the teams vacating the rink from the previous game will shovel the ice shavings off the rink that was just used allowing the new game to have a fresh sheet of ice. Natural pond ice is very different than artificial ice in an arena. Our maintenance crew will be working tirelessly on any ice imperfections to make the experience as enjoyable as possible as well as the Concord Parks and Recreation Department who will be on-site to further sweep each rink as frequently as needed. 
Capital City Celebration

This year the Black Ice Pond Hockey Championship is to center piece a city wide celebration. For the third year the Long Traiser Brewery has produced Black Ice Ale for the tournament. Several Concord Area restaurants have Black Ice on draught in celebration of the third annual tournament: The Red Blazer, Buffalo Wild Wings, TGIF, Pit Road Lounge, Cheers, The Barley House, The Gas Lighter, The Centennial Inn, The Draft, O's Steak & Seafood, Tandy's Top Shelf, Blaser's Fireside, Makris Steak & Seafood Penuche's and CC Tomatoes. In addition to pouring Black Ice Ale, The Barley House, Cheers Bar & Grill and Constantly Pizza are the official restaurants of the pond hockey tournament. These restaurants have great promotions, discounts and activity running during the Black Ice Tournament.



Part of what makes the Black Ice so special is the desire to acknowledge the history of hockey in the Concord area. The first three years The Black Ice Pond Hockey Association has acknowledged parts of this rich hockey heritage. St. Paul's School in Concord was recognized in year one as the location of the first organized hockey game played in the United States. It was also the where the great Hobey Baker attended school. The Sacred Heart Hockey Club was recognized in 2011. The "Sacre Coeur" played on an outdoor rink behind the Sacred Heart Church from the 1930's thru 1952. The program's highlight was in the winter of 1952 when the Hearts hosted the US Olympic team for a game before they left to the Olympics in Oslo.

In 2013 we would like to acknowledge White Park. The Park has a significant connection to generations of locals whether it was for leisure or sports activity. This very pond that we are skating on today has played a prominent role in the evolution of skating and hockey in Concord from the early 1900's. The City of Concord received this land as a gift from Armenia White in memory of her husband Nathanial White (founder of the American Express Company). White Park sits on 23.4 acres and is defined by 5 residential streets (Washington, Centre, White, Liberty & Beacon). In the mid 1880's the landscape architect Charles Elliott designed the Park. Two ponds were excavated to help direct the flow of water from the hillside springs. Other elements include the Stone Bridge (included in the Black Ice Pond Hockey Logo) which was constructed in 1896, the steel picket fence surrounding the park built after 1905, and the fieldstone shelter referred to as the "Trolley Stop" in 1906.



Hockey on the pond dates back to the winter of 1910-11 where the Concord Monitor and Patriot writes about two teams competing, The Concord Young Sluggers and The Young I.O.C. Other teams like the White Park Warriors 1915, Concord YMCA 1922, Walker School, Garrison School 1924, Concord High School Independents 1924, White Park Hockey Club and Southend Hockey Club 1928 played at different times and were based out of White Park. In 1932 Officer Tom Andrews of the Concord Police Department started The White Park Hockey League. The six teams were White Park, Westend A.C., Southend Wildcats, West Concord A.C., Walker Street Rangers and The Southend Shamrocks. White Park remained the focal point of organized hockey in Concord until The Douglas N. Everett Arena was built in 1966. (History provided by New Hampshire Legends of Hockey.)
