BVI ICE BAR

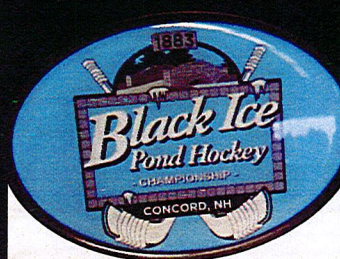
